After 48 years Kennedy House Youth Services Inc. continues to provide safe, productive and healthy services to youth across the GTA, through our group homes, after school programs and outreach programs.

In 2014 we opened a 40 bed youth shelter in East York which consistently has 100% occupancy each night, helping service the over 2,000 homeless youth in Toronto.

Your support gives our youth so much more than just a warm place to sleep at night. You also help to provide:

- Private and semi-private bedrooms
- Three healthy meals a day
- Counseling in shelter and in day programs
- 24 hour care in our group homes
- Free After School programs
- Financial literacy courses
- Education for living on a budget
- Help finishing school
- Guidance on finding employment
- **And a fresh start...**

In 2018:

80% of youth residents at the shelter were a visible minority

32 youth were able to secure permanent housing.

80 youth attended and or graduated from school.

And let's not forget the shelter was able to provide more than **14,600 safe night sleeps** and over **43,000 healthy meals**.

- In 2017, over 30,000 walkers & 90,000 donors from Newfoundland to Yukon to Vancouver helped raised \$4.6 million
- 66% of walkers are female
