



## Preliminary TTC work on Broadview Avenue Overhead upgrades, rail welding and storage

**Timeline:** Starting early June 2023

### What we are doing and why



Preliminary work is required in advance of the Broadview Avenue Streetcar Track Renewal project which is scheduled from July 4 to late November 2023. The project will bring the track infrastructure to a state of good repair. Work will also include road resurfacing and repairs to damaged sidewalks and curbs in the area. ### TTC overhead infrastructure upgrades

**Where:** Broadview Avenue between Danforth Avenue and Gerrard Street East

**When:** Early June to early July 2023

**TTC service:** 504 King/505 Dundas buses will continue to operate on Broadview Avenue until June 17. **On June 18, 504 King/505 Dundas service will be suspended – there will be no 504 King/505 Dundas service at Broadview Station.**

**Work hours:** 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly

**Traffic:** Reduced lanes, traffic maintained both ways during overhead work.

**Equipment:** On average, two to three TTC overhead trucks with hydraulic equipment will be used to carry out this work. While efforts will be made by the crew to keep noise to a minimum, beeping sounds from back-up alarms on the TTC trucks will be audible. Equipment lights may also be noticeable.

### Preliminary rail welding

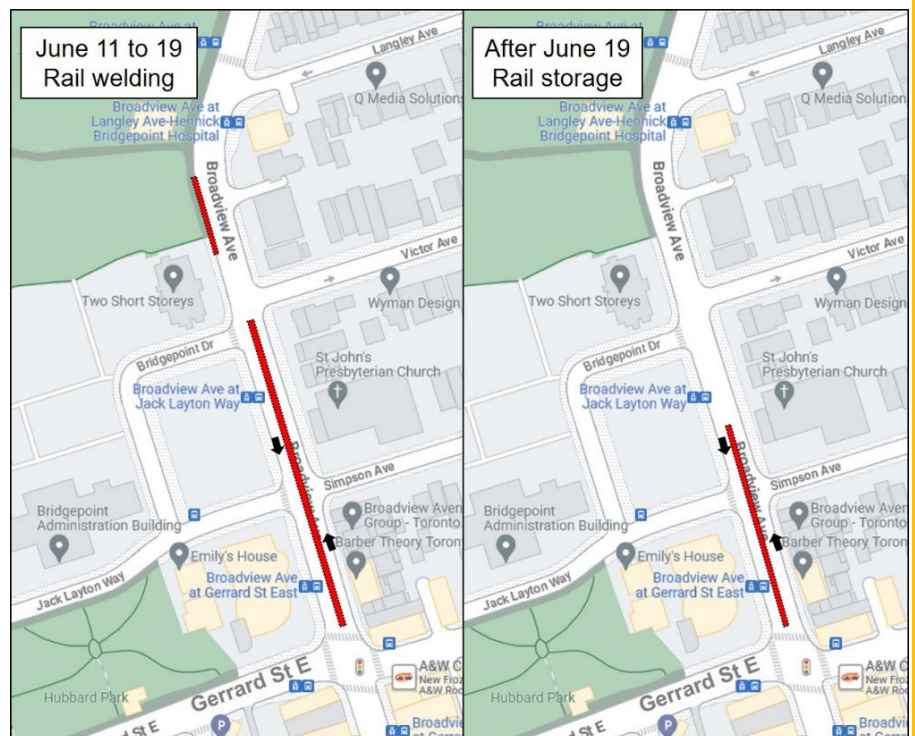
**Where:** Broadview Avenue between Gerrard Street and Victor Avenue in the centre lanes

**When:** June 11 to 19 (approx. one week)

**TTC service:** 504 King or 505 Dundas maintained through the work zone until June 17. **121 The Esplanade-River** will turn west on Gerrard Street East instead of Jack Layton Way.

**Work hours:** Welding work during daytime hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Some overnight activity will occur such as moving rail into position and deliveries to support daytime welding operations.

**Traffic:** Traffic will be maintained both ways through the curb lane along Broadview through the work zone and rail storage may inhibit left turns from local streets onto Broadview Avenue.



**Additional work details:** On **Sunday, June 11**, crews will deliver rail and material to the site throughout the day starting at 7 a.m. Starting on **Monday, June 12**, crews will begin welding together standard lengths of rail into longer strings to facilitate faster track installation, reducing the construction disruption to local communities. The long strings of rails will then be stored in the centre lanes until required. The rail pile will deplete as track work and new rail installation progresses over the course of the Broadview Avenue Track Renewal project.
